- Attend one meeting each term (usually in the evening)
- Visit the school once a term to see how things are going
- Take part in safeguarding training
- Read some information and reports so you can take part in discussions

You will receive training, a clear induction, and a mentor to help you learn the role.

Why become a governor?

Many people find that being a governor helps them:

- Feel more connected to their child's school
- Learn new skills and gain confidence
- Understand how schools work
- Use their knowledge and skills to make a real difference to children's lives

We are keen to hear from people with a wide range of life experiences and backgrounds.

We would also love to hear from anyone with building /health and safety knowledge.
